# HISTORY-SOCIAL SCIENCE

## “a” Subject Requirements

### UC-CSU Requirements for Freshman Admissions

**Two years of history/social science**

- ✦ **Including one year of U.S. history or one-half year of U.S. history and one-half year of civics or American government;**
- ✦ **and one year of world history**
- ✦ **CSU-one year of other approved social science**



# English

## “b” Subject Requirements

- Four years of approved courses
  - CP (College Prep)
  - Honors
  - AP (Advanced Placement)



# MATHEMATICS

## “c” Subject Requirements

- **Three years**

- **Math I**
- **Math II**
- **Math III**
- **4<sup>TH</sup> Year Recommended**

- **UC- (Four years recommended)**



# SCIENCE

## “d” Subject Requirements

- Two years with lab required (UC/CSU)
  - Integrated Sciences
  - Environmental P or HP
  - The Living Earth
- Three years recommended



# FOREIGN LANGUAGE-LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH “e” Subject Requirements

- Two years of the same language required.
- Three years recommended



# VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS

## “f” Subject Requirements

- One year of Visual and Performing Arts chose from the following:

MUST BE THE SAME CLASS

- Dance
- Drama/Theatre
- Music
- Visual Arts





# College-Preparatory Elective “g” Subject Requirements

- One year of academic courses in the previously mentioned areas.

# Division I Requirements NCAA Core Courses (16 Core Requirements Must Be Completed)

- **English** (ALL 4 Years)
  - Grammar, Composition, Literature  
Eng IA/IB, Eng IIA/IIB  
Eng IIIA/IIIB, Eng IVA/IVB
- **Mathematics** (min. 3 Years)
  - Math I, Math II, Math III
- **Natural/Physical Science** (min. 2 years)
  - Environmental Science, Biology, Physics,  
Physiology, Chemistry
  - (1 year lab science if offered by high school)
- **Social Science** (min. 2 years)
  - History
  - Government
  - Sociology
  - Economics
- **Additional Course(s)** (1 full year)
  - From only:
    - English
    - Math
    - Natural/Physical Science
- **Additional Courses** (min. 4 years)
  - Additional courses from:
    - Above categories
    - foreign language,
    - Philosophy or non-doctrinal religion

# University of California (UC)

- How to get in:
  - Must meet A-G (UC) requirements
  - Must write a personal statement/essay
  - Must have letters or recommendation
- GPA, and Community Service
  - GPA minimum is 3.5
  - Must meet eligibility index
  - Community Service is a must!!!
- Cost:
  - approx. \$39,736 with on campus housing
  - \$24,824 without housing

# Cal State (CSU)

- How to get in:
  - Must meet A-G(CSU) requirements
- GPA, SAT's, and Community Service:
  - GPA minimum 3.5
  - Community Service not necessary but recommended
- Cost:
  - Approx. \$28,312 with on campus housing
  - \$22,174 without housing

# Independent Colleges & Universities

- There are more than 75 campuses through out California
- Entrance Exams varies depending on the college campus.
- Contact the school to find out admission requirements and deadlines



# Private University

- How to get in:
  - Do not use A-G requirements alone
  - Personal interview
- GPA, SAT's, and Community Service:
  - Like to see at least a 2.5
  - SAT's not required but recommended
  - Community Service is not required
  - Check with each school for requirements
- Cost:
  - Depending on the University average cost is approx. \$55,820, with grants, scholarships, and state and government aid it is 24,811 (USC = 66,640 - 90,921)per year.





# 109 California Community Colleges

- Degrees offered= Associates of Arts/Science
- Vocational Certificates
- Transfer track
- No subject requirements to be admitted.
- Take English and Math Placement test.
- Be 18 years of age, or
- Be a high school graduate, or have a GED.



# Community College

- How to get in:
  - High school diploma or 18 years of age
- GPA, SAT's, and Community Service
  - No requirement
- Cost:
  - Approx. (tuition- \$0 because of the Community College Promise Grant, books -\$1,656, Miscellaneous - \$3,096)



# Different ways to pay for college

- Grants/Financial Aid – do not need to pay back
- Scholarships – do not need to pay back
- Student Loans – will need to pay back
