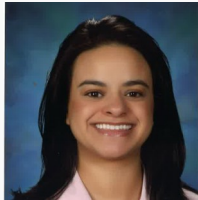

Distance Learning Plan



Boyd Elementary School will begin the school year using the Bridge Academy (Distance Learning) Instructional Model.

Bridge Academy - Students will learn at home in a structured virtual format. A designated certificated teacher will utilize a variety of instructional strategies including scheduled interactive whole class and small group instruction in addition to independent work. Several Virtual Classroom sessions will be held throughout each school day and attendance and participation is compulsory. Students earn grades on assignments and report cards as they would in a traditional school setting.

* The district may be able to transition to a hybrid model later on during this school year.

Hybrid Model - The hybrid model combines on campus and at home learning. Students will attend school campus Tuesday– Friday either in the AM or PM and will be assigned independent work for the remainder of the school day and for days they are not on campus. Attendance and participation is compulsory. Students earn grades on assignments and report cards as they would in a traditional school setting.

IMPORTANT

If the district should be able to transition to the hybrid model at a later time this school year your child's teacher assignment may be adjusted to accommodate parent request/choice, whether that be remaining in Bridge Academy or transitioning to our Hybrid Model.

Covid-19 Updates



On **Friday, July 17, 2020**, Governor **Gavin Newsom** took action related to the opening of schools for the upcoming school year. He announced that schools in Counties that are on the COVID-19 watch list will start the year with Distance Learning. In-person instruction may resume only when a county, currently on the watch list, is off the watch list, for 14 consecutive days.
