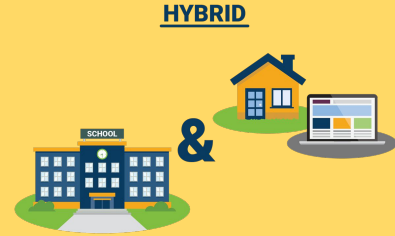

1 Hybrid Model



Hybrid Learning provides in-person instructional time for students at school and at home allowing the District to comply with social distancing requirements.

How Often?

Students will be enrolled in two groups (am or pm), and physically report to school on Tuesday through Friday. Monday schedule will remain as it is currently, at home.

Times?

AM: 7:50 am -10:55 am
PM: 11:55 am -2:55 pm

Safety?

Site Level Leadership will ensure safety precautions such as Daily Temperature Checks, Social Distancing, and School-Wide Disinfecting. Students will be required to wear a mask the entire time on campus. Students will be in the classroom the entire time on campus.
