WHAT IS A COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE WORKER?

Community Healthcare Workers are trained public professionals who serve the community by providing resources such as: nutrition and food services, employment resources, legal services, culturally relevant needs, health resources, and more.

LICENSING & INTERNSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Possess a valid California ID or California Driver's License
- Pass a Criminal Background Check
(this includes DUI's)
- *Drug screening may be required*

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

- The following documents must be submitted along with a completed application at the time of registration.
- High School Diploma
 - Letter of intent for admission
 - **2 professional** letters of recommendation*
- *All letters of recommendation MUST be SIGNED and DATED within the last three years.
(Typed signatures will NOT be accepted)*

ACCEPTANCE INTO THE PROGRAM WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION BASED ON THE DOCUMENTS PROVIDED. CANDIDATES WILL BE NOTIFIED IF ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM.
