BTSA Support Provider Job Description

DEFINITION

Full time Beginning Teacher Support and Assessment (BTSA) Support Provider. The BTSA Support Provider will provide onsite guidance, assistance, and information to BTSA teachers to aid in their development of effective professional practices and will engage preliminary credentialed teachers in a job-embedded formative assessment system of support and professional growth to fulfill the requirements for the Clear Multiple Subject/Single Subject credentials. The position will be for one year, renewable annually for up to three consecutive years based on continued funding, successful completion of job requirements, and a satisfactory yearly evaluation.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Develop a sustaining mentoring relationship with each BTSA participating teacher based on openness, sharing, reflection, and trust.
- Guide and assist the BTSA participating teacher in developing and implementing and Individual Induction Plan (IPP) based on the California Standards for the Teaching Profession.
- Hold regularly scheduled on-site support sessions with the new teacher, provide on-call assistant and on-going informal discussions, complete non-evaluative classroom observations, and facilitate other classroom observation opportunities.
- Participate in all professional development activities for Support Providers including FACT modules, monthly training meetings, and SB 2042 credential requirements.
- Assist BTSA teachers in developing and maintaining an individual portfolio to be used in the formative assessment process.
- Participate in support and training activities for beginning teachers and Support Providers.
- Provide staff development on BTSA related topics for teachers/interns in need of such support.
- Provide feedback on program effectiveness to site administrators and the Senior Director, Professional Development Center.
- Participate in the program evaluation process.
- Comply with BTSA program reporting procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

- BTSA program is preferred.
- Appropriate State curriculum frameworks and Content/Performance Standards.

Ability to:

- Communicate effectively with other professionals.
- Demonstrate ability to work collaboratively with beginning teachers.

Experience and Education:

- At least five (5) years of exemplary classroom teaching experience and/or mentor teaching experience which includes assessing student learning, creating and maintaining effective environments for student learning, and designing learning experiences necessary to meet the needs of a diverse student population.
- Possession of a valid California clear teaching credential.
- Bachelor's degree or higher degree from an accredited college or university.
- Tenured certificated employee.
- CLAD certificate or equivalent.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Physical class:

Moderate Work: - lifting 50 pounds maximum with frequent lifting and/or carrying objects weighing up to 25 pounds.

Work area requirements:

Regular classroom, on the playground, parking lot, bus stop areas and possibly field trips. Ability to traverse campuses and sites of 10 to 40 acres which would include asphalt, grass on playgrounds, and dirt.
