  - Strategic Site Goal Setting
    - School mission statement discussed
    - Discussed Kolb MS demographics
    - Achievement data discussed
      - Overall, decrease of 3% in ELA CAASPP, Kolb is still the highest performing
      - Overall, decrease of 2% in Math CAASPP, Kolb still the highest despite the decrease
      - ELPAC Data, level 3 students had an increase compared to other levels.
      - Reclassification of EL students went from 11% to 20%
      - Discussed math and Reading IReady data by sub group.
      - D/F rate- quarter 1, overall, 16% of students with a "D" or "F" in English and 12% of students have "D" or "F" in math.
      - Referral data discussed (A1, minor tardies, K, and 48900.4)
      - Suspension data: 12.4% population suspended 22/23, 3.64% current (correction needs to be made on "Suspension Data" dates)



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- Chronic absenteeism 22/23 24.3%, and 23/24 is 18.4%
- Strengths: great students, and teachers. Supportive families
- Challenges: declining enrollment, facility issue with drop offs, aging facility and quad area, limited parking, no additional classroom space available.
