**Key Elements, Principles:** Texture, Space (Depth through Overlapping), Proportion

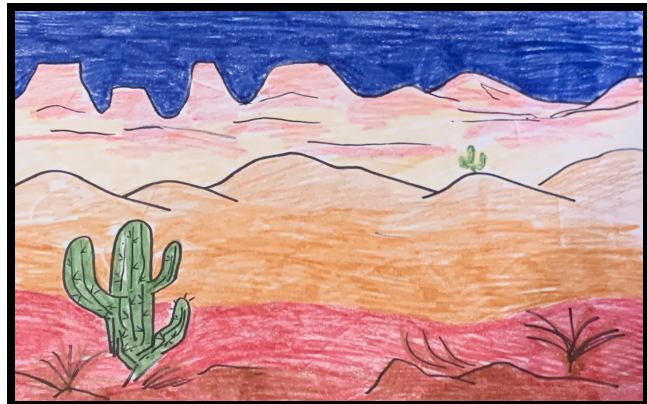
