We have started using our new check-in system. Please be aware that anytime you wish to come on campus past the front office, you will need your identification. Your ID will be scanned by the computer system, and a visitor pass with your photo will be printed for you to wear while you are at Casey. When you leave, you will need to pass through the front office again and check out.

If you are coming to an event such as a performance or an awards assembly, please come early since there is only one computer and we need time to help everyone get scanned.

There is nothing more important than creating a safe learning environment for our students and staff. This new system will help us ensure that the visitors we allow in campus have been screened and verify that they have a legitimate purpose prior to entering Casey. It will also allow us to account for all occupants in the event of an emergency. We ask for your support as we all adapt to the new system.
