








2016 ELA CAASPP Overall: All Students



ELA 2-Year Comparison




2016 ELA CAASPP Overall: All Students by Grade Level




2016 Reading Claim

How well do students understand stories and information that they read?




2016 Writing Claim

How well do students communicate in writing?




2016 Listening Claim

How well do students understand spoken information?




How well can students find and present information about a topic?




2016 Math CAASPP Overall: All Students



Math 2-Year Comparison




2016 Math CAASPP Overall: All Students by Grade Level




2016 Concepts & Procedures Claim: All Students

How well do students use mathematical rules and ideas?




2016 Problem Solving and Modeling/Data Analysis Claim

How well can students show and apply their problem solving skills?




2016 Communicating Reasoning Claim
