

In alignment with our mission and vision, we are launching a Healing Plan for Students, Staff, and Community, guiding our work from April 2025 through June 2026. This initiative is designed to enhance equity, promote safety, and strengthen collaboration among all educational partners.



Strategic Leadership

To ensure the successful implementation of this plan, Dr. Kennon Mitchell has been appointed Project Lead (Consultant). Dr. Mitchell will coordinate contracted service providers and advise the District strategically to improve instructional coherence, collective efficacy, and leadership development. Dr. Rhea McIver Gibbs, Deputy Superintendent, will oversee his efforts, ensuring alignment with the district's goals. Co-developers and key implementers are Dr. Ayanna Ibrahim-Balogun, Dr. Robin McMillon, Chief Norberto Perez, Joseph Williams, consultant Mike Medina, and community partners.

Prioritizing Safety & Student Well-Being



Recognizing the critical need for enhanced safety, RUSD will hire a Chief of Safety and Intervention to lead the district's security efforts. Until a permanent leader is in place, Miguel Medina, a seasoned expert with 32 years in law enforcement and 25 years in school district safety, will support this transition. Mr. Medina will assist the District in the following areas:

- Crisis Prevention & Response Strengthening school-wide safety measures.
- **Behavioral Interventions** Training staff in conflict resolution and crisis de-escalation.
- Anti-Hate & Anti-Bullying Initiatives Implementing district-wide awareness and prevention campaigns.

Implementation & Accountability



This plan will be launched in April 2025, with continuous evaluation through June 2026. Regular updates will be provided to ensure transparency and accountability in achieving our goals.
