REOPENING PLAN



<p>Facial Coverings</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students, staff and visitors must wear a face covering in order to enter the school. One disposable face covering and one reusable face covering will be provided to every staff member and student. Additional face coverings will be provided as needed. Students and staff will not be required to wear a mask at recess or most outdoor situations. Students will be able to remove their masks while eating.
<p>Sanitizing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Classrooms, restrooms, and lunch tables will be disinfected at the end of the day or as needed. All classrooms are provided with air purifiers and hospital-grade filters Students will not be bringing any items or objects from home to school Water drinking faucets will be off limits until further notice. Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles. Water bottle filling stations will be available at most sites. Each site will have a water source or other water supply. Students will be encouraged to wash hands regularly while at school.
<p>Social Distancing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Up to 3ft of distancing for student desks and 6ft of distance for teacher desks While outside of the classroom, floor markers will be used to determine appropriate distancing LUNCH: The capacity for the cafeteria will be reduced to 50%, and with weather permitting, students will be able to eat outside in our covered patio area. BREAKFAST: Will be served in the classroom. Hand sanitizer will be available and encouraged for use before eating. Sharing food is discouraged. Visitors will be limited to the front office PLAYGROUND: Playground equipment may be used. Sites must ensure that students wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after use. BUS RIDERS: Drivers will take the temperature of all students prior to them boarding the bus. Bus drivers and bus riders (students & attendants) must wear a face covering at all times.
<p>Screening</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperature checks will occur daily upon arrival to school. There will be multiple entry points designated at each school. Parents are encouraged to check their children's temperature prior to leaving the home. Click HERE for symptoms. If a student has a temperature higher than 100.4 °F or other COVID-19 related symptoms, the student will be escorted to the Isolation Room and parents will be contacted. The Health Clerk and School Nurse will supervise the Isolation Room as needed.
<p>Classroom Supplies & Electronics</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each student will receive their own electronic device and instructional supplies to discourage cross contamination. Students are to bring fully charged devices daily. Elementary school classrooms will provide Plexiglas on individual student desks. Custodians will disinfect Plexiglas daily based on the new COVID cleaning schedule.
<p>Independent Study</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Independent Study Programs will be offered to students whose health would be put at risk by in-person instruction, as determined by parent or guardian, or for families not yet comfortable with in-person learning. Registration process will begin at each school site's office. Contact the school to request a referral.
<p>Social Emotional Support</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Every school site will provide Social Emotional Learning (SEL) instruction. Site administration have been trained in restorative and trauma informed practices. Counseling is available to students and families. Family connection to community resources ie, food, clothing, etc., is available Site COSAs and counselors will work with at-risk youth by caseload and provide social emotional support as needed
