All summer school courses are offered contingent upon authorization and funding by the California State Department of Education. The Rialto Unified School District reserves the right to cancel any or all course offerings.

District dress code and school site rules apply for all students attending summer school classes. Unacceptable behavior may result in removal from summer school classes.



ACADEMIC CLASSES - GRADES 10 -12

If students are absent on the first day of class, or absent from class a total of 1 ½ days, they will be dropped from the class. Three (3) tardies = one absence. Students are cautioned not to enroll for only one semester of a year-long course, except for remediation or make-up. The last day to drop a class and not receive a grade for 1st Semester will be June 11, 2021. The last day to drop a class and not receive a grade for 2nd Semester will be June 24, 2021. Students who do not complete the academic summer school may forfeit future summer school enrollment opportunities.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

This year summer school is highly recommended for students who:

- Are seniors who need fifteen (15) semester credits, or fewer, in order to earn a diploma prior to September

- c. Have failed classes and are in need of remediation

If your student does not meet the above criteria, the student may petition to attend summer school:
